DECISION OF THE SUPREME JUDGE OF THE 2ND KWU KYOKUSHIN WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP AMONG MEN AND WOMEN IN WEIGHT CATEGORIES

January 13, 2016

In order to support the principal of fair play and fulfill the requirements of the World Anti-Doping Agency WADA, according to the Provision of the 2nd KWU World Championship, the results of the Doping testing and the explanations received from the athletes and coaches, I announce the following decision:

1. To invalidate the results of the athletes of the 2nd KWU World Championship among men and women in weight categories that was held in October 3-4, 2015 in Khabarovsk due to the detection of prohibited substances in urine samples of the following athletes:

In weight category women under 55kg:

Stanislava Boycheva (Bulgaria) - metenolone and its metabolites 16a-hydroxy-1-methyl-5a-androst-1-en-3,17-dione and 1-methylene-5a-androstan-3a-ol-17-one;

In weight category men under 70 kg:

Hojat Samehzada (Afghanistan)- furosemide;

In weight category men under 75 kg:

Svyatoslav Erenkov (Russia) -metabolite of tamoxifen (3-hydroxy-4-metoxymetoxifen);

In weight category men under 85 kg:

Farshad Shahyari (Iran) - metabolites of nandrolone, norandrosterone and noretiocholanolone;

In weight category men under 90 kg:

Bahman Khandani (Iran) - metabolites of nandrolone, norandrosterone, noretiocholanolone, boldenone and its metabolite (5 β -androst-1-ene-17 β -ol-3-one);

In weight category men over 95 kg:

Hristo Georgiev- metabolites of nandrolone, norandrosterone and noretiocholanolone.

2. To deprive the following athletes of the titles – Champions/Prize-winners of the 2nd KWU World Championship among men and women in weight categories and disqualify them for 2 years since January 1,2016:

Stanislava Boycheva (Bulgaria) - is deprived of the 1st place;

Hojat Samehzada (Afghanistan) - is deprived of the 3rd place;

Sviatoslav Erenkov (Russia) - is deprived of the 2nd place;

Farshad Shahyari (Iran) - is deprived of the 3rd place;

Bahman Khandani (Iran) - is deprived of the 3rd place;

Hristo Georgiev(Bulgaria) - is deprived of the 3rd place.

3. To oblige all athletes listed in paragraph 2 to return the official medals and trophies of KWU World Championship to the Organizing Committee of the World Championship.

4. In weight category women under 55kg:

- a. To acknowledge the athlete Anna Virabyan (Russia) as the World Champion and award her with the official gold medal, trophy and diploma of the World Championship.

- b. To give the athlete Violeta Litovska (Bulgaria) the second place and award her with the official silver medal, trophy and diploma for the second place in the World Championship.
- c. To keep the third place for Aleksandra Lesniewska (Poland) without changes in her title and awards.

5. In weight category men under 75 kg:

- a. To give the athlete Deyan Bratkov (Bulgaria) the second place and award him with the official silver medal, trophy and diploma for the second place in the World Championship.
 - b. To keep the third place for Carlos Escribano Preciados (Spain) without changes in his title and awards.
6. To acknowledge the official results of the 2nd KWU World Championship among men and women in weight categories (October 3-4, 2015, Khabarovsk):
